IMPORTANT BOARDING UPDATES AND REMINDERS

January 8th, 2019

After much consideration, Branchwater Kennels will be putting into place the following changes beginning February 1st, 2019.

- **Boarding Rates will increase to \$30/dog/day**
- **For dogs who can be kenneled together the rate will be \$25/dog (\$50 per kennel).**
If, during the stay, it is determined by the Branchwater staff that it is not safe for dogs to be kenneled together, they will be separated at the discretion of the staff and owners will be charged for the 2 kennels. Dogs who are kenneled together must be able to eat together and share any toys and bedding brought along. We do not encourage any owners to put dogs together if they have concerns in the home.
- **Food provided by Branchwater is now \$2/day. Branchwater is feeding Victor. We highly recommend bring the food your dog is accustomed to at home.**
- **For boarding stays lasting 7 days or more, a bath will be included at no additional cost.**
- **For stays longer than 10 days, there will be a 10% discount applied.**
- **Nails will now cost \$10 per dog**
- **Baths will be \$30 for dogs 30 pounds and under and \$40 for dogs above 30 pounds.**
Please note: Our goal is that your dog has a pleasant experience at Branchwater Kennels. If we notice that your dog is exhibiting signs of extreme stress or signs of aggression at the time of bath and/or nails, we will not complete the treatments. We hope that your dog is happy at Branchwater and, while we are always careful and loving with the dogs in our care, would not want one experience with a bath or nail trim to ruin their outlook on their stay with us.
- **Extra play will now be billed \$30/hour for one dog and \$40/hour for multiple dogs.**
- **VERY IMPORTANT: Any dog kenneled with us must be brought with their up to date vaccination record every stay as we do not keep them on file. With many infectious diseases on the rise, this is crucial in ensuring the safety of all dogs at Branchwater. Vaccines required are Rabies, DHPP, Leptospirosis, Bordatella, and now H3N2 Influenza.**

We so appreciate your understanding regarding these changes. Our goal at Branchwater is to provide the best care we can to dogs entrusted to us. We are a small business and each of our employees seek to create a bond with the dogs staying with us. Your trust in us is appreciated and we hope to see your four-legged family members soon.
